Classes taught:

- Accounting Information Systems *2002 – Present*
 - Only instructor for this course that is required for all accounting majors.
 - This course is the gateway course for accounting students before they can take additional upper level accounting courses.
 - This class is taught in a technology classroom so that students have an active learning experience. Quizzes and exams are online as well as some in class activities.
 - All three of UMSL's recent Elijah Watts Sells winners have attended and completed this class.
 - Since teaching this course I have included new software in the course including GL Software and Access. Students are also required to use technology to record their own group presentations.
 - Topics that I have included in this course include REA Data Modeling, XBRL and Information Literacy. Students are currently working with Quickbooks Online.
 - When technology necessary for this class is not supported by IT Support, I am responsible for technical issues.
 - Excel is taught using MyITLab for all sections of this course.
- Fundamentals of Financial Accounting *2000-Present*
 - This course is the introductory course in accounting. Usually taught in 16 week sections.
 - Experience teaching in 4 and 8 week summer sections as well as 8 and 16 week regular semester sections.
 - Online section since Fall 2013
- Managerial Accounting *Summer 2013& 2014*
 - 4 week and 8 week format
 - 4 week format uses a blended instructional method (online and face to face)
